


Setting up the Gradebook in Moodle Units

- 1. Select to the **UNIT** from your home page: https://moodle.pia.edu.au/
- 2. Select **GRADES** on the left side of the page.
- 3. Go to the drop-down box and select **GRADEBOOK SET UP**.



4. Here you will see all assessments and weightings for the unit



5. Check that the name and weighting of each assessment **matches** the unit outline. If you need to change the final (max) grade, click on the **EDIT** button and go to **EDIT SETTINGS**.



6. Here you change the maximum grade of a particular assessment. Once you have done this, scroll to the bottom and click the **SAVE CHANGES** button.


IMPORTANT: Ensure the Course Total setting is on "Weighted Mean of Grades"




TROUBLESHOOTING

If your gradebook doesn't have a weighting column, there are 2 potential fixes:

Go to "Edit" as circled below and select "Edit Settings"








Ensure "Weighted Means of Grades" is selected

Ensure "Exclude empty grades" box is unchecked.

This should fix the issue and the weightings will now be visible to you.



Alternatively, it might be that there's a formula in your gradebook. If you have the correct gradebook setting, you don't need to enter a formula.


Delete the formula by going to "Edit" as circled below and click on "Edit Calculation"

You will then need to ensure that "Weighted mean of grades" is selected and you should see the weightings column appear.



CHECKLIST TASKS

Ensure that assessment names and weightings match the unit outline and assessment screenshot on the Moodle unit.



Check that the course total has 'weighted means of grades' underneath



Ensure 'Exclude empty grades' is unselected
