


How to Setup Self Selection of Student Groups


The purpose of this is to allow students to select their own student groups for their assessments. You can set limiting parameters such as minimum and maximum group sizes as part of the settings.

To add this activity, turn editing on your Moodle page and add an activity. Then select the Group self-selection icon.



Then you can name it- Example: STT500 Assessment 3 Self- Select Group. You may wish to also add a description.


You can also set when you want the self-selection of groups to be available by editing the open and close dates and selecting the enabled check boxes.






IMPORTANT

In order that students can only select student assessment groups and not class groups, ensure you have selected the correct grouping. In the example below, this is STT500 Assessment 3 that we created when setting up our groups and groupings. See previous resource from instructions on how to do this.




Group parameters. You can specify the minimum and maximum number of students in a group. It is recommended you follow the default that students can only be in one group at a time.
